

Access to the Museum is tightly protected.All areas are individually alarmed, locked and under 24-hour surveillance.

- Staff have been trained and selectively chosen to work around prestige modern and classic cars. Volunteers likewise have been chosen for their passions and experience.
- The Museum's founder has a sizeable collection of classic cars and memorabilia. We apply the same learned techniques for managing his collection to managing exhibitors' items. Including, but not limited to using trickle chargers to protect batteries, and only using specially formulated detailing materials and cleaning techniques.
